# KABC WALL OF FAME NATIONAL ALL ACADEMIC TEAM

**Qualifications:** The Knights Wall of Fame is established to recognize individual Central Penn College athletes excelling nationally in their academic and athletic career and selected by its national governing affiliation such as USCAA, NCAA to the National All-Academic Team or its Sport's All-American Team.

# USCAA National All-Academic Team Guidelines:

- All student-athletes with 24 or more credits on their USCAA transcripts shall be eligible for the National All-Academic Team.
- Overall (cumulative) grade point averages must be 3.50 (on a 4.00 point system) or greater.
- GPA's must be documented by way of an unofficial school transcript.
