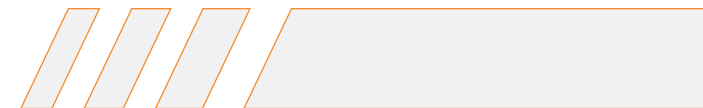

Qualifications: The Knights Wall of Fame is established to recognize individual Central Penn College athletes excelling nationally in their academic and athletic career and selected by its national governing affiliation such as USCAA, NCAA to the National All-Academic Team or its Sport's All-American Team.

USCAA National All-Academic

Team Guidelines:

- All student-athletes with 24 or more credits on their USCAA transcripts shall be eligible for the National All-Academic Team.
- Overall (cumulative) grade point averages must be 3.50 (on a 4.00 point system) or greater.
- GPA's must be documented by way of an unofficial school transcript.

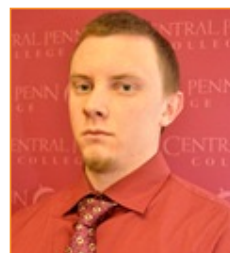

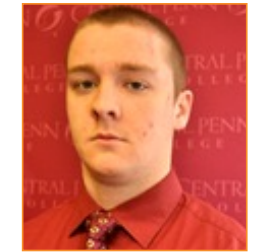

CPC BASEBALL HISTORY

USCAA BASEBALL NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

The 2017 Central Penn College Baseball Team receives its first bid in school history to participate in the USCAA National Championship tournament May 2017. Ranked 9th in the country for the USCAA.

The tournament know as the "Small College World Series" took place at East Field Park in Glenn Falls NY and was hosted by the College of St. Joseph's Vermont. This marks a historic event for Central Penn College, as this is the first time in school history that the knights have qualified for the National Championship Tournament.

Central Penn College ranked 3rd in the nation for stole bases with 81, led by a pair of freshman infielders. Todd Cook from Littleston, PA Short Stop with a .351 BA, 9 doubles and 21 RBI's and Jerry Biller III from Brandon, FL and Florida Burn, Second Baseman with a .378 BA, 3 triples, 20 RBI's and 4th in the country in stolen bases with 21

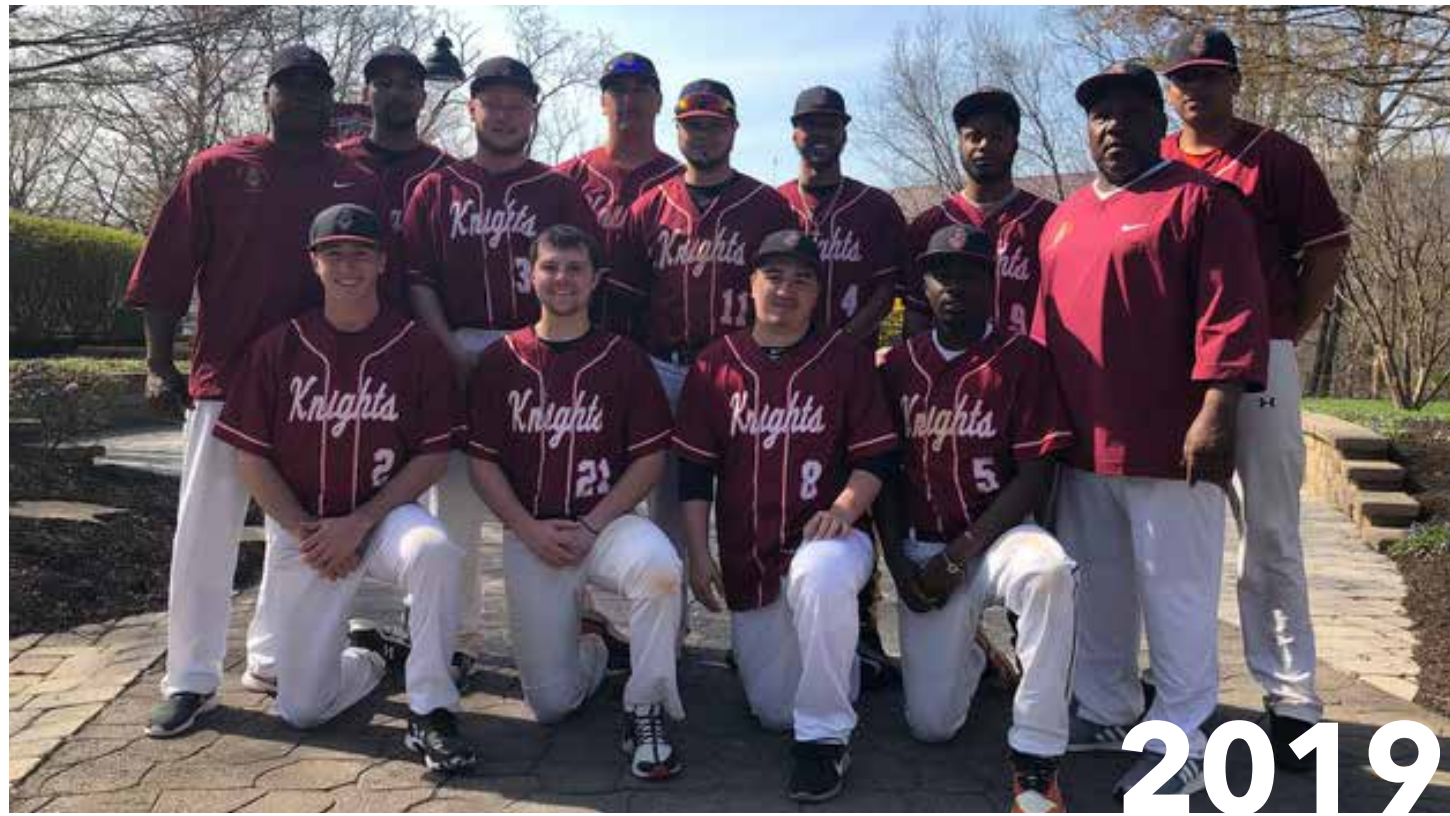

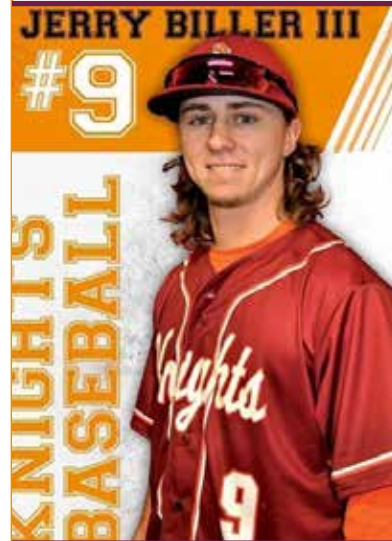

2018 **JERRY LYNN BILLER III - #9**

In 2018, Jerry Biller III was CPC's first graduate in its history to be selected to both the Baseball All American 2nd team and the National All Academic Team (2x). He graduated in just 3 years with his bachelors degree in Business. In 2017, he helped lead the CPC Baseball Team to the 1st USCAA top 10 Small College World Series with a BA of .333. Jerry was a USCAA leader batting, OBP, and ranked 5th in the country in Stolen Bases with 21 in a season. Jerry secured many school records along the way to include, Co-Male Athlete of the Year, Career Averages of .67 Stolen bases per game with 36, B.A. of .380 with over 200 plate appearances, OBP .492, FPCT. 944.

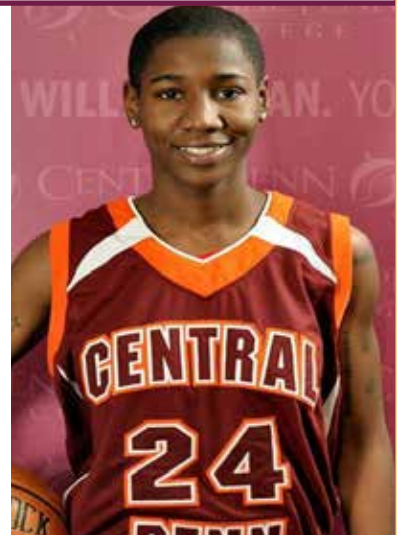
